

To improve the health and wellness of Asian American communities in Montgomery County by applying equity, community engagement, and data-driven approaches.







## What can AAHI do for you?




- Refer and connect you with needed health, social service, and mental health services

- Request print copies of our health education materials





## **COVID-19 Cases & Test Positivity Rates**






## **COVID-19 Hospitalization Rates**







## **COVID-19 Vaccinations: Totals from CDC**

#### **TOTAL VACCINATIONS (AS OF 1/11/22)**

- ≥95%\* of total population received at least ONE DOSE [N=1,037,547]
- 84% of <u>total</u> population received at least TWO DOSES (fully vaccinated) [N=883,123]
- 44% of <u>fully vaccinated</u> population received a BOOSTER/ADDITIONAL DOSE [N=384,526]






Chart reflects percent of total age group population that received doses. Percentage estimates are reflected as ranges for ages 12-17 and ages 5-11 due to higher margins of error.

- 49% of the <u>fully vaccinated 18+ population</u> received a BOOSTER/ADDITONAL DOSE [N=372,377]
- 69% of the <u>fully vaccinated 65+ population</u> received a BOOSTER/ADDITIONAL DOSE [N=115,667]

<sup>\*</sup> The CDC caps percentages at 95% to account for margins of error in data entry and population estimates.





## MCPS COVID-19 Mitigation Measures

- Mandatory masking in schools
- Distribution of KN-95 masks
- Contract tracing (letters sent to students who need to quarantine for 10-days)
- Enhanced ventilations
- Encouraging vaccination
- Increased access to testing
  - Take-home rapid test kits will be distributed to students and staff
  - In-school COVID-19 testing

## **MCPS Student Health Checklist**

Any student who tests positive will be required to isolate for 10 days from the date of the positive test or 10 days from the onset of symptoms, whichever comes first.



Please review the questions daily and KEEP CHILDREN HOME if the answer is YES to any question. YES OR NO, DO YOU HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS? YES Feeling feverish and/or having chills, with a temperature of 100.4°F or higher Sore throat A new cough that is not due to another health condition Difficulty breathing Diarrhea or vomiting New onset of severe headache New onset of loss of taste or smell Have you had a positive test for COVID-19 within the past 10 days? Have you been tested for COVID-19 because you were sick and are still waiting for the lab results? In the past 14 days, have you been in close contact with someone who had any of the above COVID-19 symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19? CLOSE CONTACT IS: Being less than 3 feet away in the classroom for 15 or more minutes during a 24-hour period, regardless of mask use. Being less than 6 feet away while eating or outdoors for 15 minutes or more during a 24-hour period, regardless of mask use. If you have any questions, please contact your local school.
